QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING

Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual. Finished Quilt Size: 58" x 67"





This quick and easy quilt uses a 10x10 pack...just cut all the squares in half diagonally and sew together HST's as shown in the Block diagrams or as you prefer. This quilt is 7 blocks down and 6 blocks across. All of the blocks finish at 9".

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

1. Sew together 10" HST's following the BLOCK Diagrams below. Square BLOCKS to 9-1/2"



QUILT ASSEMBLY:

2. Sew BLOCKS 1-15 together in rows and then sew Row 1 to Row 2 and so on...



BORDER ASSEMBLY: *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE ALL BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.*

3. Sew (1) A 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to left and (1) to right of quilt center. Then sew (1) A 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to top and (1) to bottom of quilt center as shown in **Quilt Diagram** on the next page.
