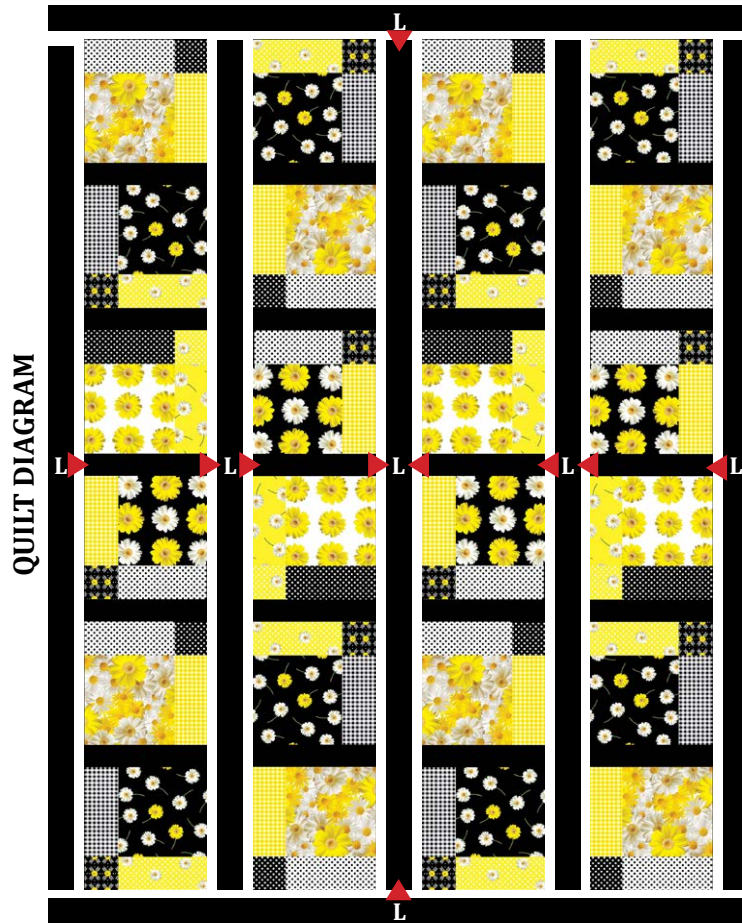


Border Assembly: Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting instructions. Follow the Quilt Diagram below.

4. BORDERS: Sew (1) L 2 ½" x 76 ½" strip in-between each row and to to left side and (1) to the right side of **QUILT CENTER**. Then sew (1) L 2 ½" x 54 ½" strip to top and (1) to bottom of **Quilt Center**.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

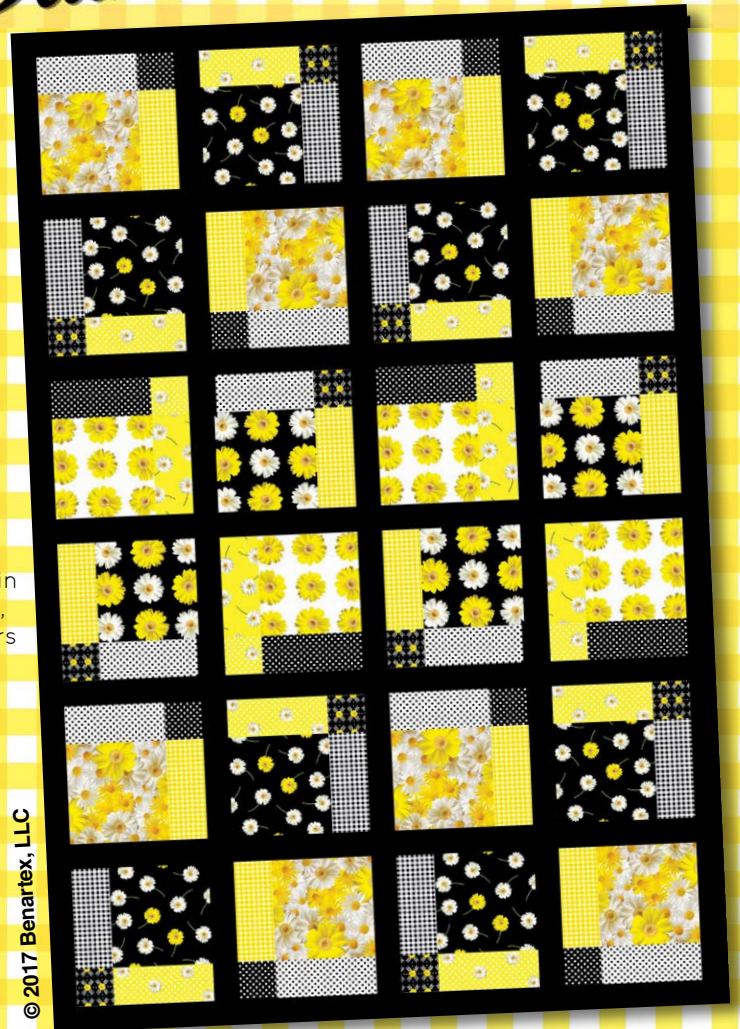

D	Window Daisy 8737-12 Black	1/4 yd	(4) 5½" squares
E	Oops Dot 8740-09 White	1/3 yd	(12) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
F	Gingham 8741-33 Yellow	1/3 yd	(12) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
G	Oops Dot 8740-12 Black	1/4 yd	(8) 3½" squares (4) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
H	Daisy Dot 8739-09 Yellow/White	1/4 yd	(8) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles (4) 3½" squares
I	Gingham 8741-12 Black	1/4 yd	(8) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
J	Daisy Geo 8738-12 Black	1/4 yd	(12) 3½" squares
K	Oops A Daisy 8735-33 Yellow	1/8 yd	(4) 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles
L	Colors For Quilters 3000H-09 Black	2 yds	(7) 2 ½" x WOF strips, subcut (20) 2 ½" x 11 ½" rectangles (13) 2 ½" x WOF strips*, <i>Sashing & Borders</i> (7) 2 ¼" x WOF strips*, <i>Binding</i>

WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC | HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES | *SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS

This simple quilt is only made up of 1 easy block with various fabrics and rotated.

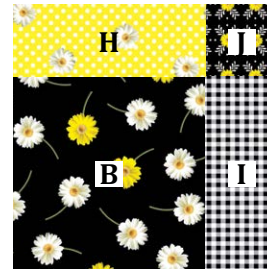
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) F 3½" x 8 ½" rectangle to the right side of (1) A 8-1/2" square. Sew (1) G 3-1/2" square to the right side of (1) E 3½" x 8 ½" rectangle. Sew EG Unit to the top of AF Unit to create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 11 ½".
Make 8 Block 1's.

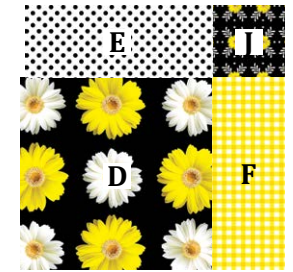
2. Repeat Step 1 replacing fabrics with those shown in the 3 diagrams below to create **Blocks 2-4**.

3. **QUILT CENTER:** Sew blocks 1-4 and L 2½" x 11½" rectangles together to create Rows 1-4 as shown below. (Note Block rotations).
